Now, as mentioned before, a bit of information about Mozart and his life. I am sure you know most of it, but it doesn't hurt to read about it again, refreshing what we have been taught at school!

Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart



Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart

(27 January 1756 – 5 December 1791), baptized as **Johannes Chrysostomus Wolfgangus Theophilus Mozart**, was a prolific and influential composer of the **Classical era**.

Wolfgang Amadei Mozart

Born in **Salzburg**, he showed prodigious ability from his earliest childhood. Already competent on **keyboard** and **violin**, he composed from the age of five and performed before European royalty. At 17, Mozart was engaged as a musician at the Salzburg court, but grew restless and traveled in search of a better position. While visiting **Vienna** in 1781, he was dismissed from his Salzburg position. He chose to stay in the capital, where he achieved fame but little financial security. During his final years in Vienna, he composed many of his best-known symphonies, concertos, and operas, and portions of the **Requiem**, which was largely unfinished at the time of his death.

The circumstances of his early death have been much mythologized. He was survived by his wife **Constanze** and two sons.

He composed more than 600 works, many acknowledged as pinnacles of **symphonic**, **concertante**, **chamber**, **operatic**, and **choral** music. He is among the most enduringly popular of **classical** composers, and his influence is profound on subsequent Western art music.

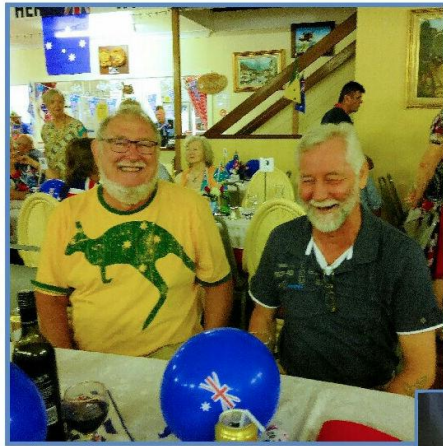

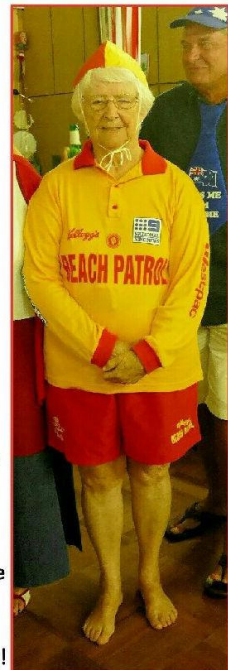


I just have to tell you, what our Joyce revealed about the great outfit she wore on our Australia Day Luncheon:
