

Though the bells were used on various types of animals, they are typically referred to as "cowbells" due to their extensive use with cattle.

Tuned cowbells or *Almglocken* (their German name), sometimes known by the English translation **alpine bells** (also *Alpenglocken* in German), typically refer to bulbous brass bells that are used to play music.


